## February 20th, 2020 Supervisors Minutes

Chairman Clapper called the February 20<sup>th</sup>, Supervisors meeting to order.

The following members were present: Don Clapper, Ted Bittinger, Mike Ferguson.

The minutes from the February 6<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved as written. The Treasurers report was distributed to each Supervisor for review.

Chairman Clapper opened with Privilege of the floor.

On a Bittinger/Clapper motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved the advertising of Ordinance 2020-02. The Ordinance has been reviewed by the Planning Committee as well as our Solicitor relating to Solar in Guilford Township. Much concern has been raised in planning as to the Township's readiness for the influx of Solar interest around Pennsylvania and our preparedness for such development in the Township.

On a Ferguson/Bittinger carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved Chairman Clapper to sign Resolution #2020-03. A MOU from Chambersburg School Districts for Guilford Hills Elementary School to use Norlo Park facilities as a temporary shelter during an emergency evacuation.

On a Bittinger/Clapper motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved Chairman Clapper to sign Resolution #2020-04, a standard service agreement from Pennsylvania One Call.

On a Ferguson/Bittinger motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved the paying of the bills. Is there any old business?

Under Old business

- Chairman Clapper presented plans that were conditionally approved for Larry Amsley on September 5, 2019 and have finally got their Zoning comment for Bill Green resolved. The Supervisors signed the plans.
- Chairman Clapper presented plans for Fitzgerald Toyota. He
  explained that they have finally decided to begin their project, and
  that they have a pre-construction meeting scheduled for tomorrow.
  We should have their revised letter of credit to cover their bond
  estimate tomorrow. The Supervisors signed the plans that were
  approved on April 19, 2018.
