On a Bittinger/Ferguson motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved the Text Amendments and Zoning Map amendment associated with the Transitional Overlay as presented

On a Ferguson/Clapper motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved the Text Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance as presented
