

January 20th, 2022 Supervisors Minutes

Chairman Clapper called the January 20th, 2022 Supervisor's meeting to order.

The following members were present: Don Clapper, Ted Bittinger, Mike Ferguson

The minutes from the December 16th Supervisor's meeting were approved as written.

The Treasurers report was distributed to each Supervisor for review.

The Re-organization meeting minutes were approved as written.

Chairman Clapper opened with Privilege of the floor – No Comment

On a Bittinger/Ferguson motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved a request for fire police from Marion Volunteer Fire Co. for a non-emergency event (Ice Fest) that is planned in the borough on January 29th.

On a Ferguson/Clapper motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved a request from Kristine Crawford to have Brenda Hill appointed as her Deputy Tax collector. Kathy Frazier is no longer interested in being the Deputy.

On a Bittinger/Clapper motion carried unanimously the Supervisors approved Resolution #2022-01 Disposition of Records. The specific records are listed in the resolution.

On a Bittinger/Ferguson motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved Resolution # 2022-02 accepting land for the purpose of a road, specifically Treeline Drive.

On a Ferguson/Bittinger motion unanimously the Supervisors approved Resolution #2022-03 accepting land for the purpose of a road, specifically Rising Sun Lane.

On a Bittinger/Clapper motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved our dates for Spring Bulk Days as May 20 & 21.

On a Ferguson/Bittinger motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved the date for the Shred Day as May 14.

On a Bittinger/Ferguson motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved the advertisement for bids. They will be advertised on Feb 7th & 11th for an opening on March 3rd.

On a Bittinger/Clapper motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved paying of the bills.
