

In addition to the regular repair and maintenance of our roadways we will be starting the construction of the Archer Drive extension to Lighthouse road. This connection will enable us to eliminate an at grade rail crossing that has been the focus of the Public Utility Commission (PUC) and Norfolk Southern Railroad for quite some time. This project is primarily funded by a multimodal grant administered by the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA).
